## **CSR** Activities undertaken by the Company

In terms of the Corporate Social Responsibility Policy of the Company and the Companies (Corporate Social Responsibility Policy) Amendment Rules, 2021, the Company had undertaken the CSR activities during FY 2020-21 amidst the global pandemic which had affected the livelihood of workers and low-income groups. The Company being committed to the well-being and betterment of the community in which it operates had provided dry ration to the migrant workers along with promoting health care services. The Company had also worked in the areas of rehabilitation and reconstruction activities.

Home First has undertaken the following CSR Activities:

- (i) Shifted the migrant workers from Ganjam (Orissa) to Surat via train and
- (ii) Providing food and essentials to the needy people in Ahmedabad and Surat.
- (iii) Contributions made to Hospitals / Institutions for promoting health care:

1.	Tata Memorial Hospital	Tata Memorial Centre is amongst the oldest and largest cancer centers in the world, with over 75 years of exceptional patient care, high-quality training and innovative cancer research.
2.	Satya Sai Heart Hospital	The hospital focuses on creating a society free of cardiac diseases, thus making a difference in the lives of people without charging a single paisa. They are serving the needy since last 12 years. The hospital is run by contributions from big corporates.
3.	Rajkot Cancer Society	A 50-year-old hospital managed by trust for cancer treatment. Trust does the treatment at discounted prices for EWS patients. This is the largest cancer hospital in Saurashtra.
4.	Seva Hospital	Hospital catering to ESG segment, largely industrial workers. They also provide low-cost medications & perform surgeries. The hospital is run by donations through local businessmen/community; local textile mkt donors.
5.	Prime Ministers National Relief Fund	Prime Minister's National Relief Fund was established entirely with public contributions and does not get any budgetary support. The resources of the PMNRF are utilized to render immediate relief to families of those killed in natural calamities like floods, cyclones and earthquakes, etc.
